The interactions are designed to test retained information and to verify that the student is actually taking the course. If a course is stopped in the middle, students can restart at the point left-off when they restart. Enrollment duration is for 90 days with extensions, should they be necessary.

Fuel Safety Supervisor 14 CFR 139.321(e)(1)

This course meets the training requirements as set forth by 14 CFR 139.321(e)(1) and AC 150/5230-4B. It is designed as the "Train the Trainer" program. The course contains 18 Lessons and a Final Assessment. Compare for yourself to see if other providers meet standard. Supervisors are required to train all others who handle hazardous materials at airports on the subjects contained in the course prior to assuming hazardous duties and every 24 consecutive calendar months thereafter. This course requires 16 hours to complete.

If supervisors do not have the time for routine academic training of personnel, our Line Fuel Service Training program can provide the training required of 14 CFR 139.321(e)(2). Please contact our Help Desk with academic or technical questions. We offer group rates on four or more students.

LinePro™ Line Fuel Service Training 14 CFR 139.321(e)(2)

This online course meets the requirements of 14 CFR 139.321(e)(2). This standard requires that all persons handling hazardous materials at Part 139 Airports be trained in a manner acceptable to the FAA Administrator PRIOR to assuming hazardous duties. The FAA mandates that line service personnel be trained in the same subject matter found in the supervisor course. With the ACE Line Fuel Service course you can be assured that your staff will be trained to the national standard. It is a self-paced program that will take 8 hours to complete.

LinePro™ Aviation Fuel Quality Control

This course will cover the sources of fuel contamination, filtration, storage facilities fuel quality testing procedures and operational procedures. It is intended to provide fuel handlers with the knowledge to effectively receive, store, test and dispense aviation fuel in accordance with industry standards. It is a self-paced program consisting of six chapters and a final assessment to gauge the retention of the information contained herein. It is a self-paced program and will take approximately 3 hours to complete.



LinePro™ Aviation Self Fueling

This 2 hour course is designed for the aircraft owner/operator who desires to fuel their own aircraft at airports requiring fuel safety training for those who handle hazardous materials. It is a significantly shortened version of our 16 hour FAA approved Supervisory Fuel Safety and Inspection Course designed for professional fuel handlers. It is a self paced program and should take approximately 2 hours to complete.

LinePro™ Ground Safety Certification (23 Lessons)

This program is a grouping of 14 OSHA courses plus our 9 Lesson **Ramp Operational Safety** program that provide new and incumbent employees the basic safety training required by 14 CFR 139 and 29 CFR 1910 of the Federal Registry. The program includes, Introduction to OSHA, Ramp Operational Safety (9 Lessons), Behavior Based Safety, Electrical Safety, Emergency Action Plans, Exits, Fire Extinguishers, Hazard Communication, Hearing Conservation, Heat Stress, Lifting Techniques, Personal Protective Equipment for Eye, Face, Head, Hand and Foot and Slips, Trips and Falls.

It is designed to be used over a 12 month period with Ramp Operational Safety as the core course. By providing your employees with the federally required training necessary for a safe working environment, accidents and injuries are reduced or eliminated, productivity and morale are increased.

Safety Training Needs Assessment
